

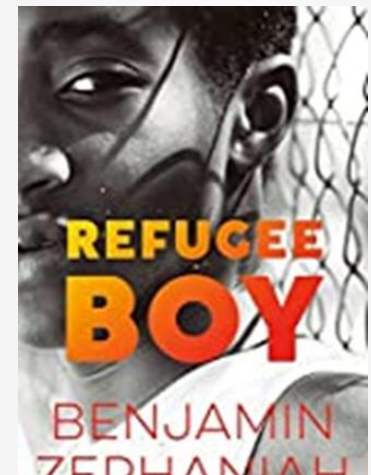
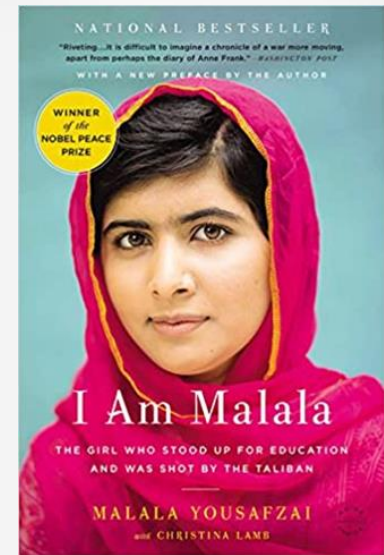
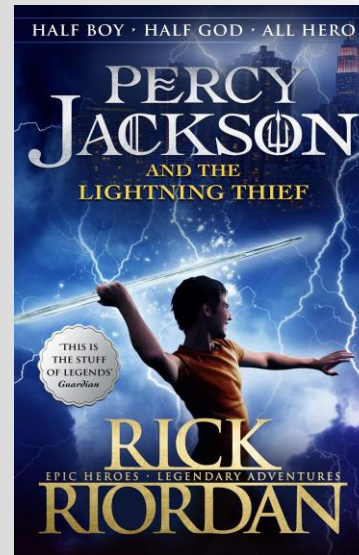
## Additional Reading in English

Additional Reading is an opportunity for you to develop your own knowledge and enjoyment of each of the things we're learning about.

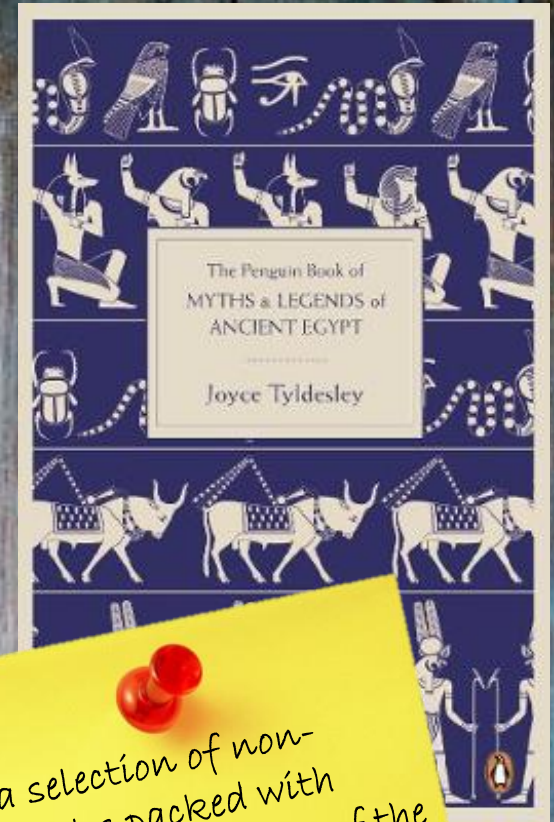
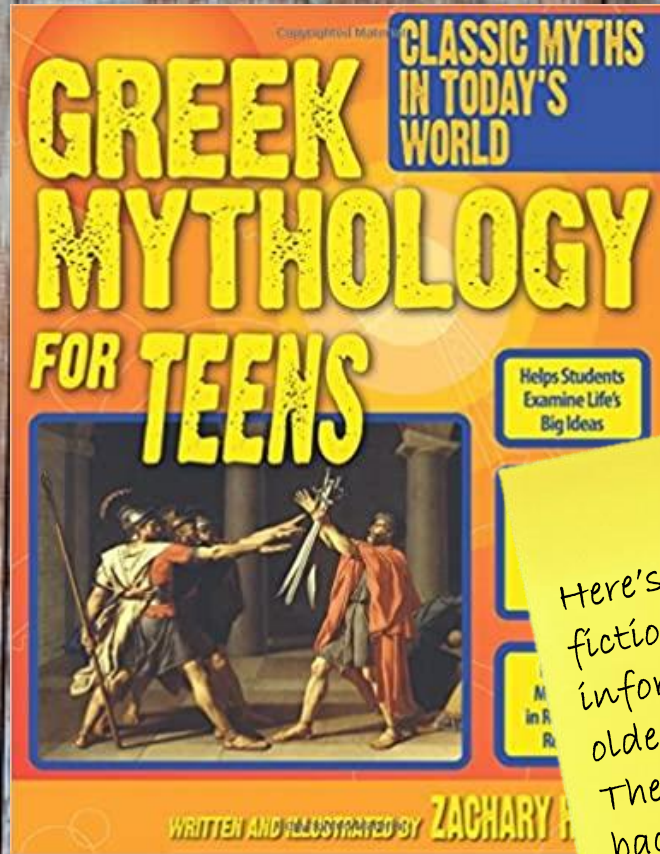

Remember to share your learning journey and findings with your English teacher and your friends.

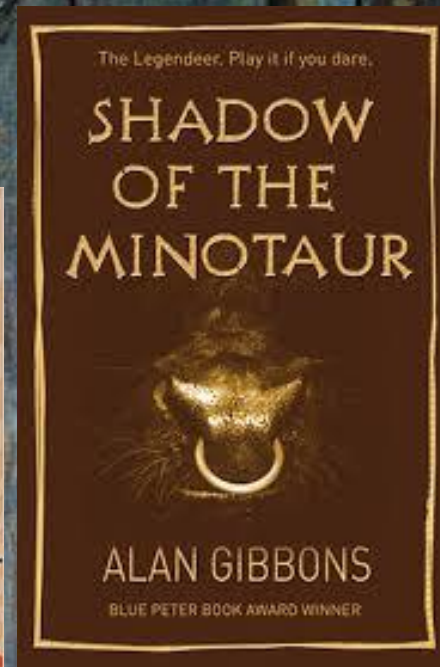
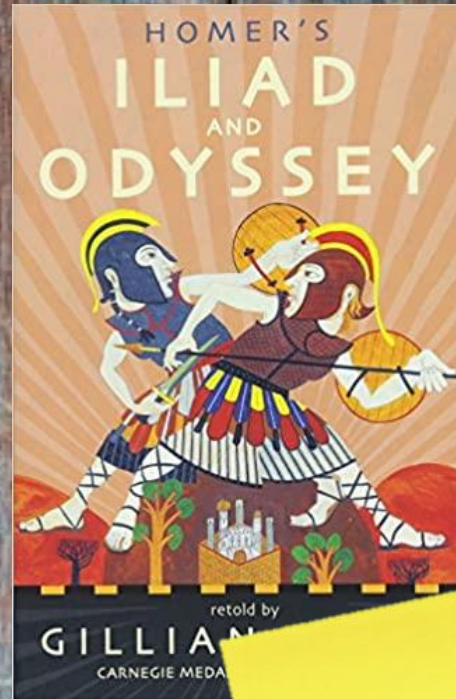
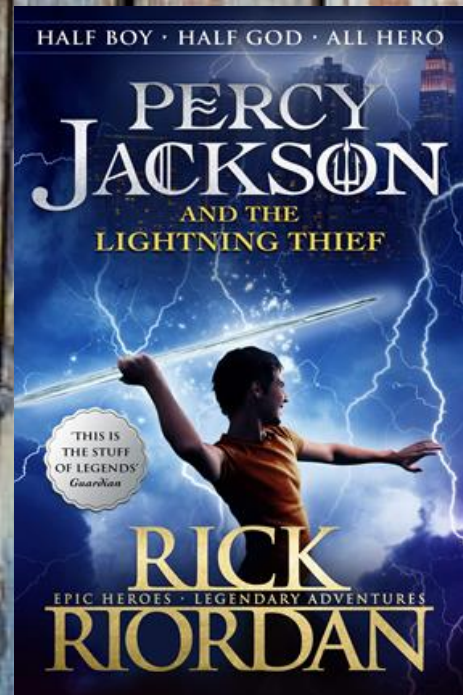

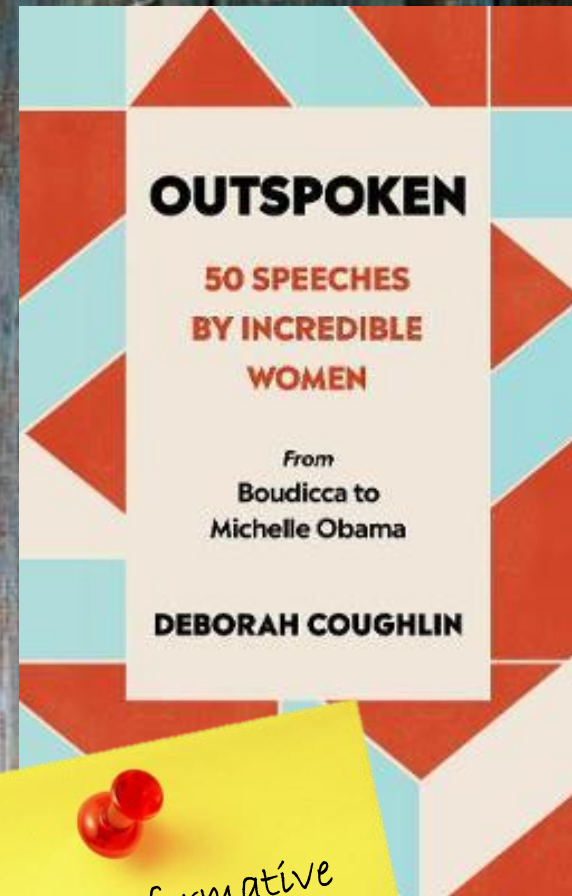
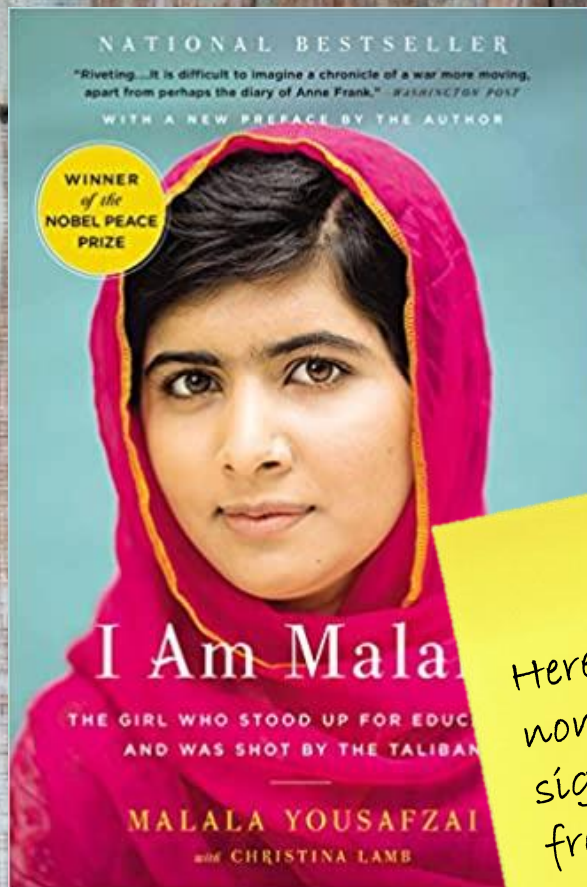
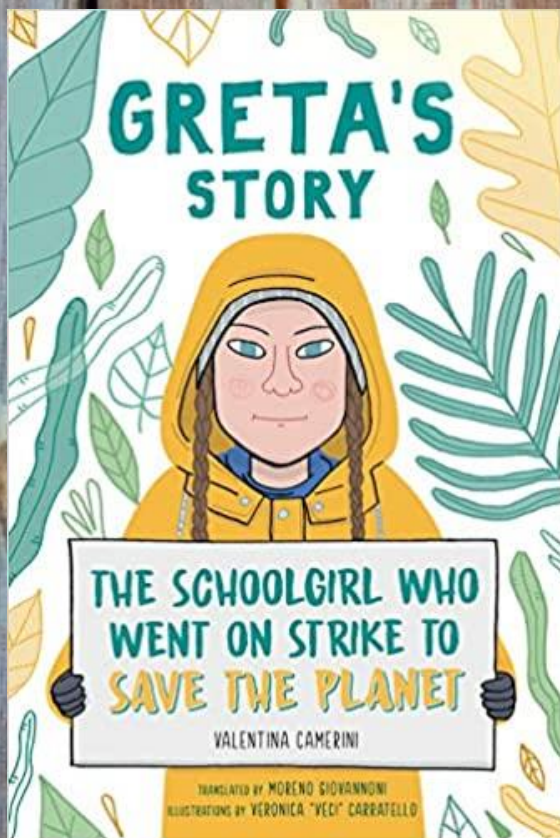
Here's a selection of non-fiction books packed with information about some of the oldest stories known to man! They're packed with background and exciting details; they also explain why these stories are still so popular today!

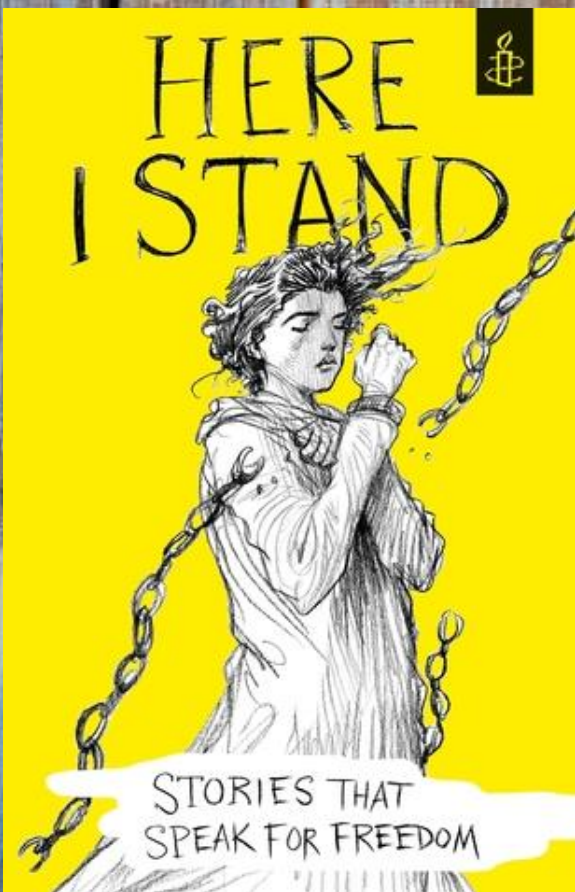
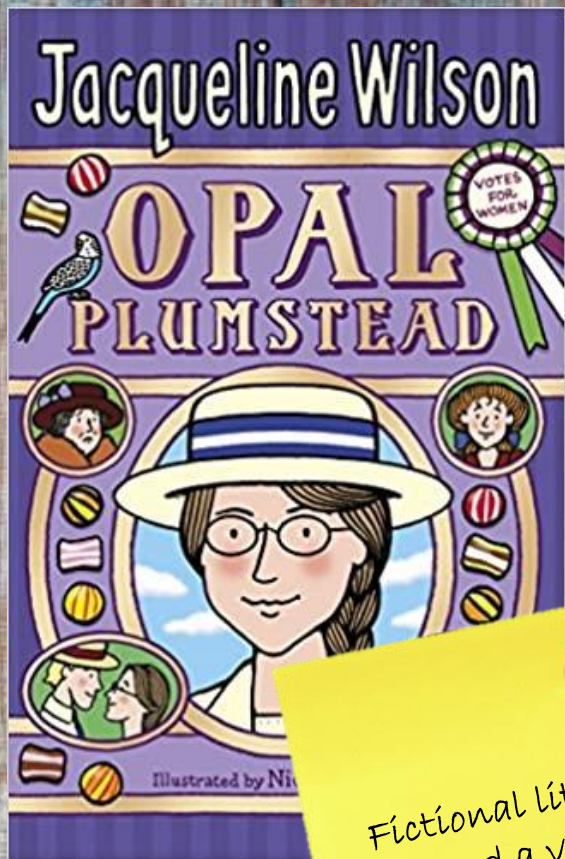
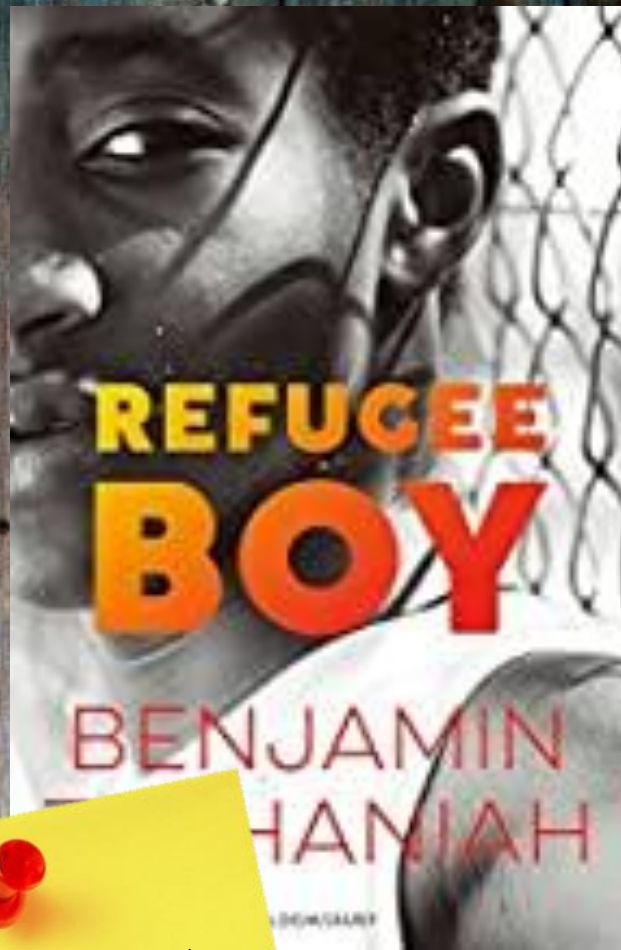


A great selection of fiction books some of which re-tell some famous myths and legends; others are based around bringing mythical stories into the modern world. Enjoy!

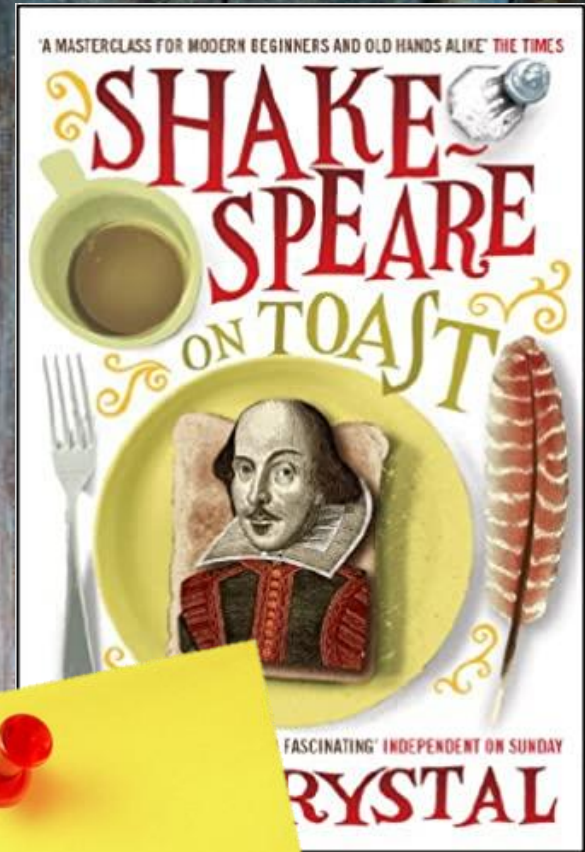
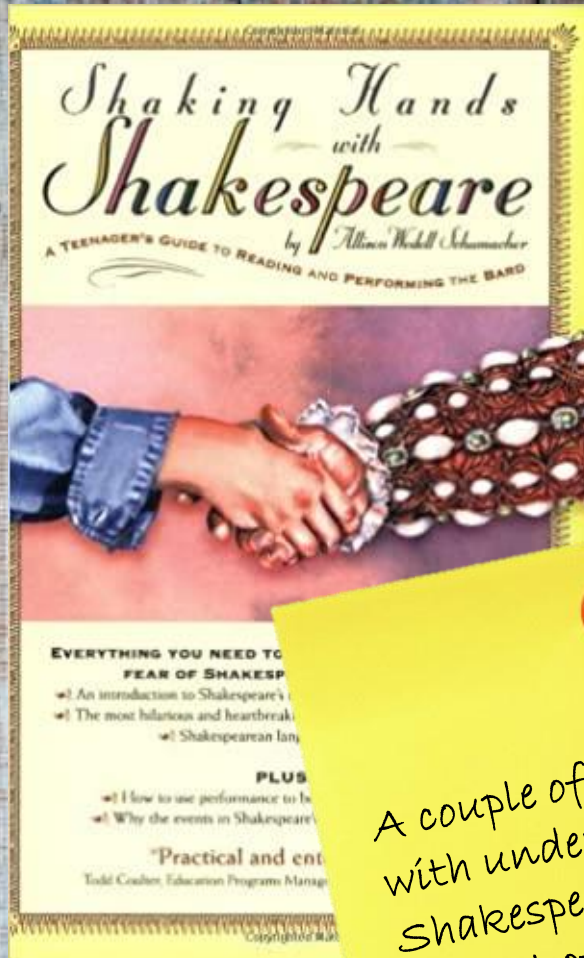
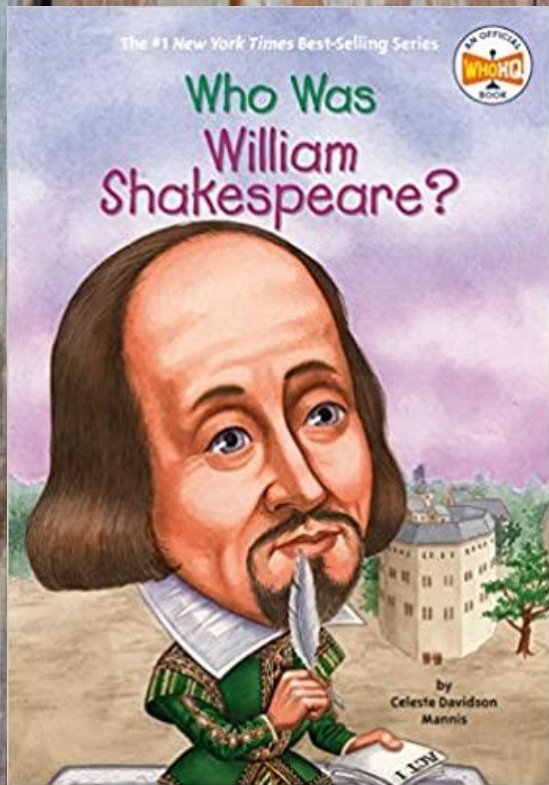


Here's some informative non-fiction books about significant speakers from the past all the way up to contemporary times!



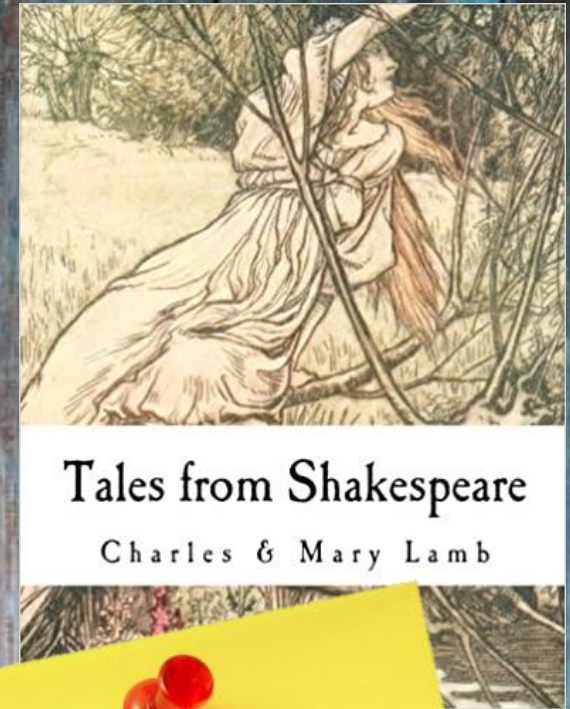
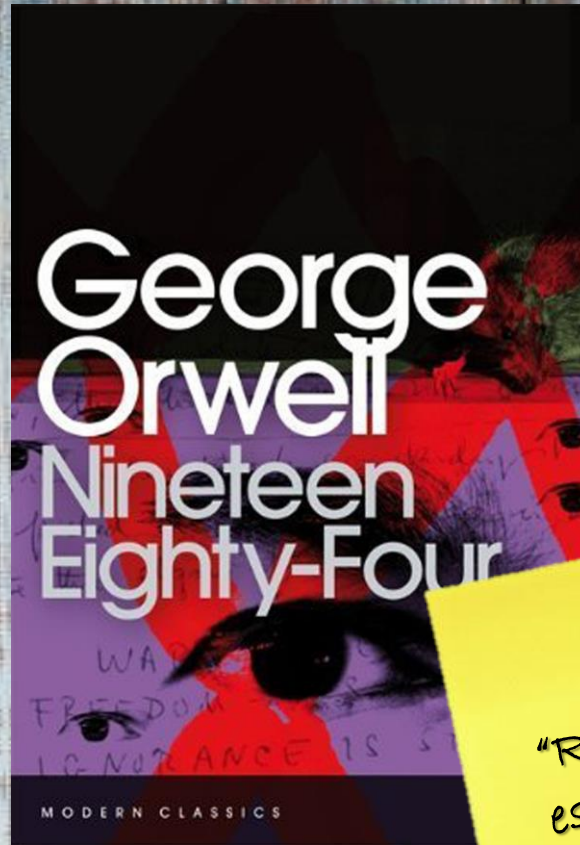
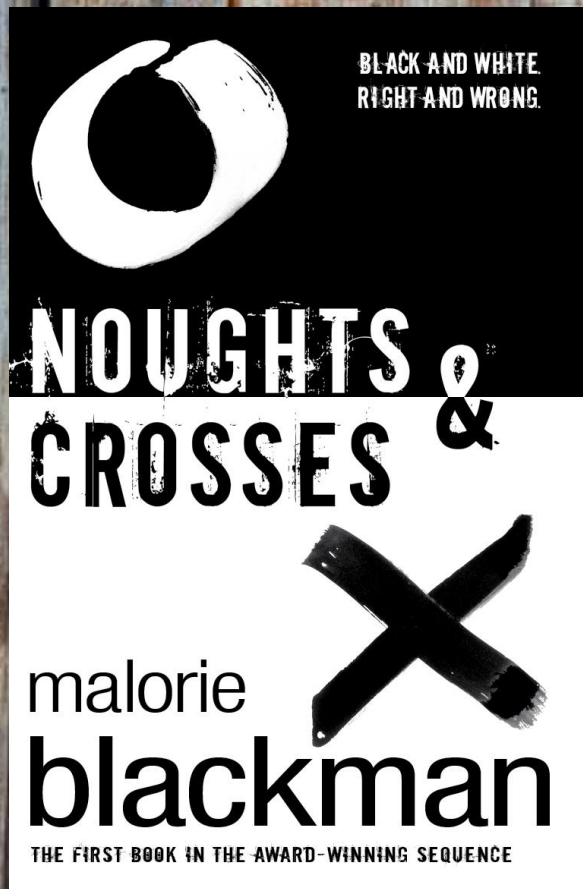
