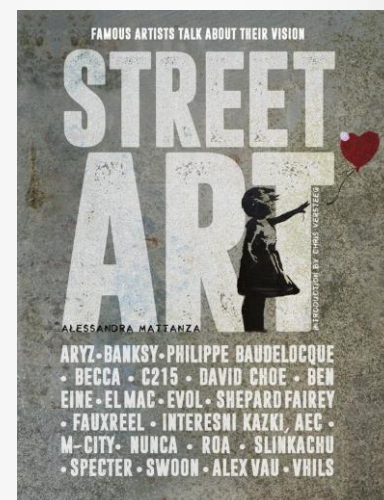
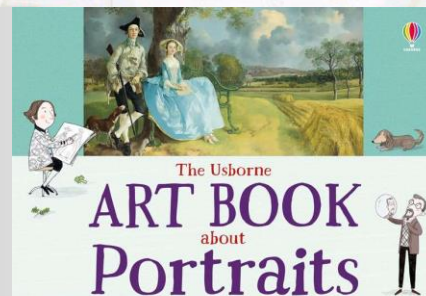
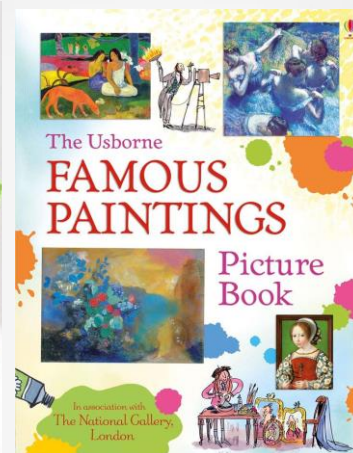
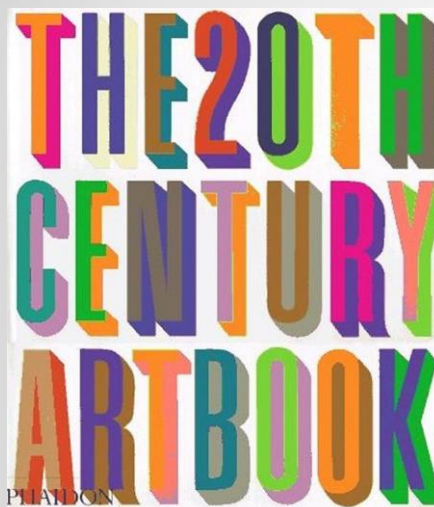
Each project comes with additional reading.

Some of the books will provide you with interesting information and some will help to go into more detail about materials and techniques that you will be using in lessons.

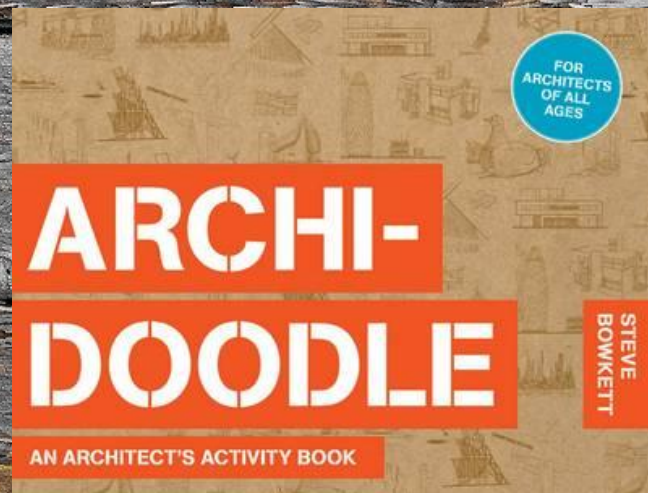
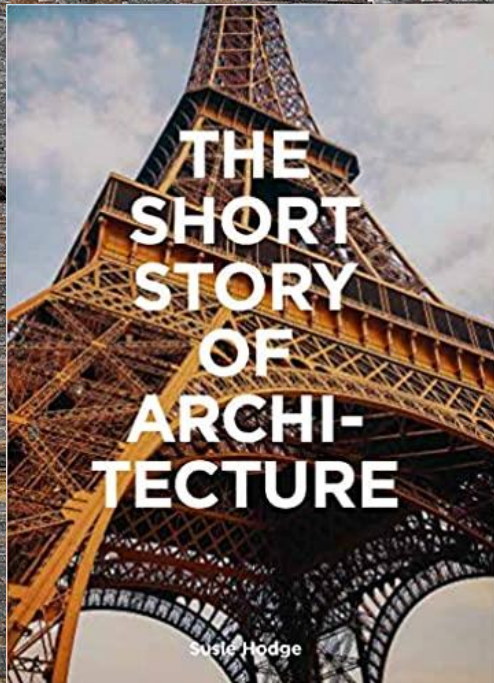
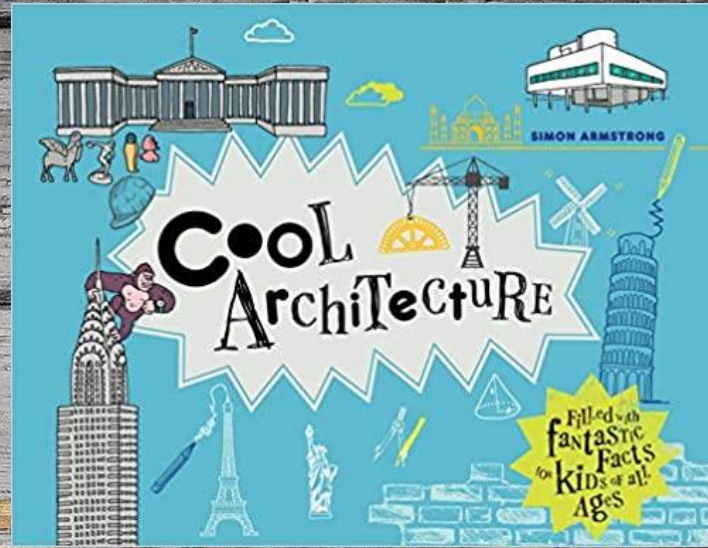
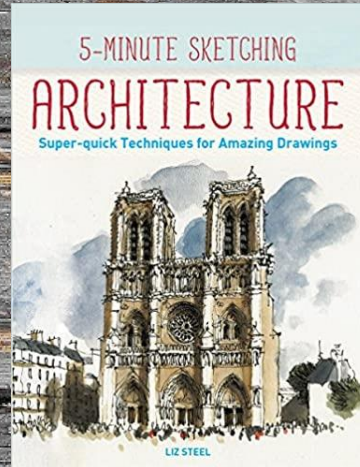
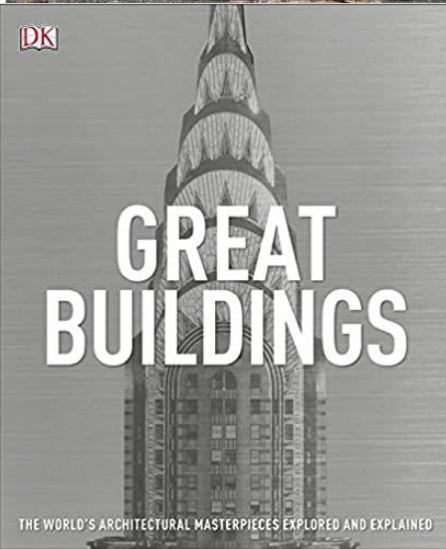
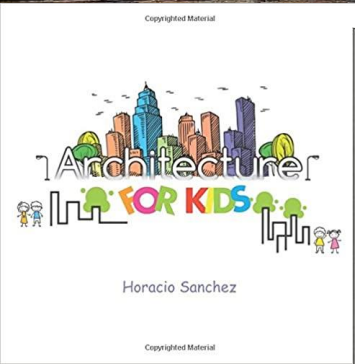
There are also interactive books, where you can record your own drawings and ideas.

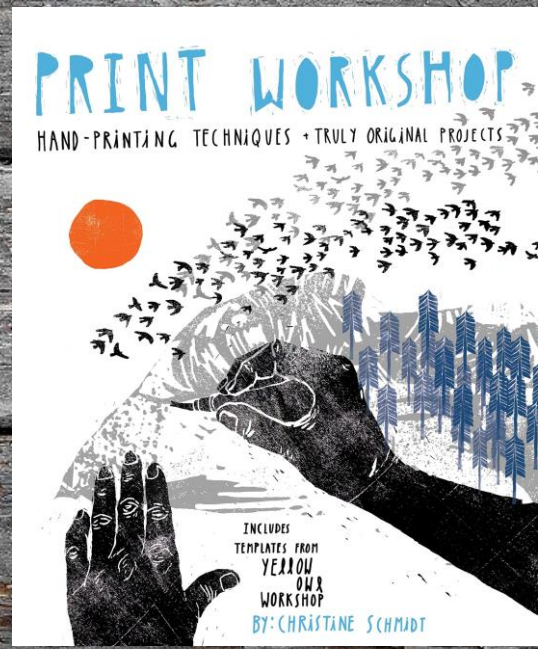
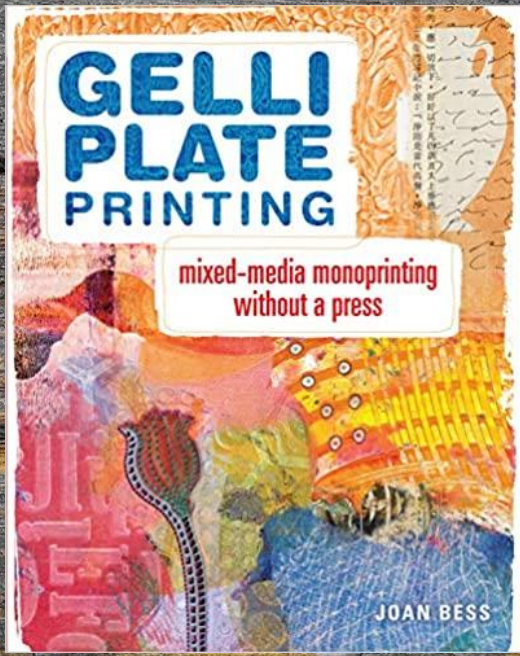
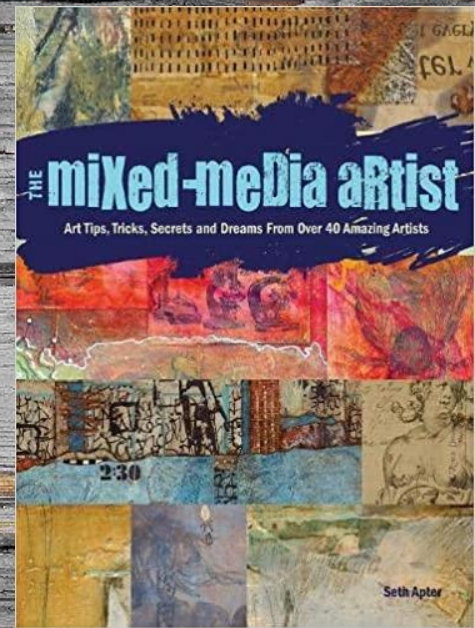
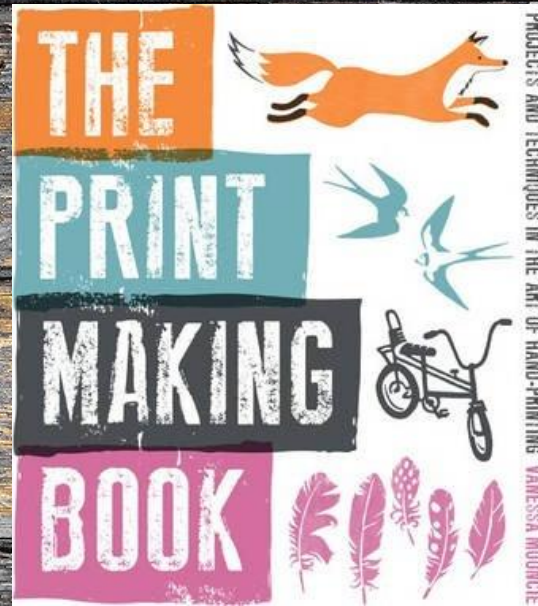
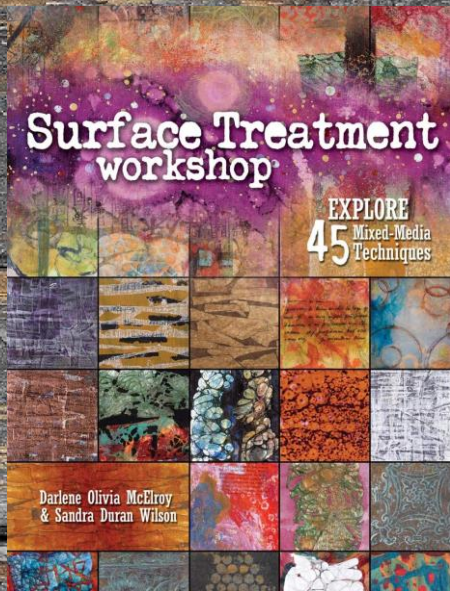
# Year 9 – Project 1 Architecture (part 1)

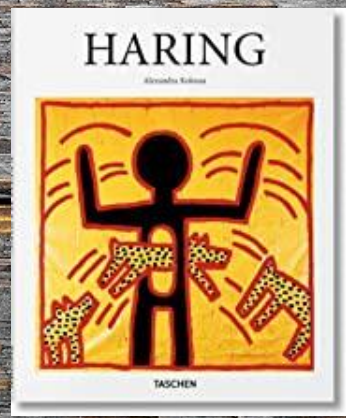
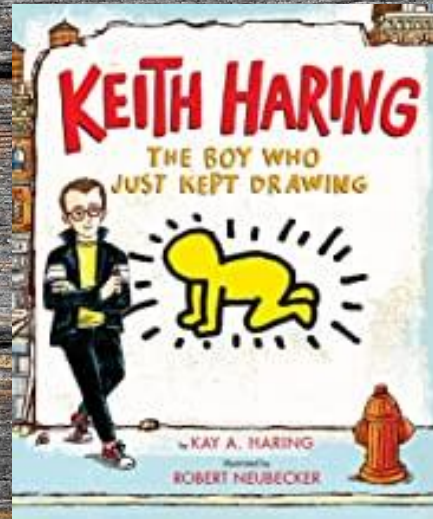
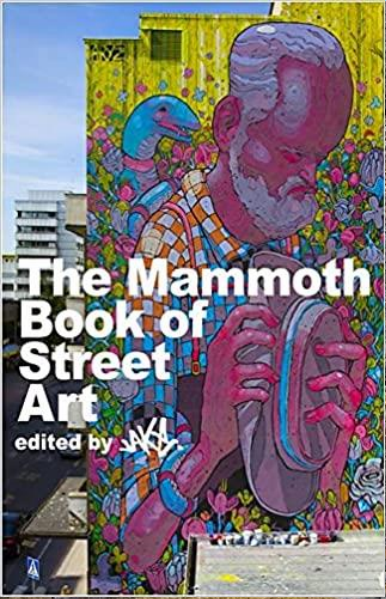
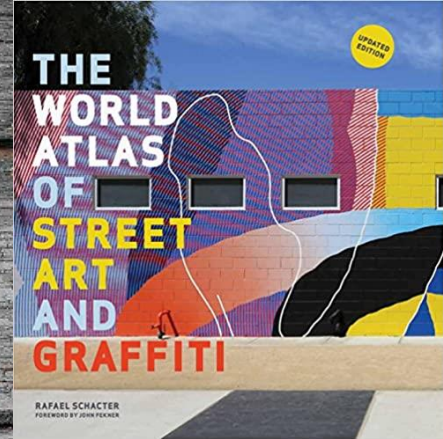
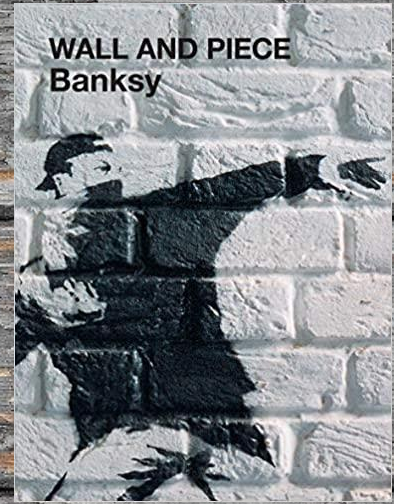
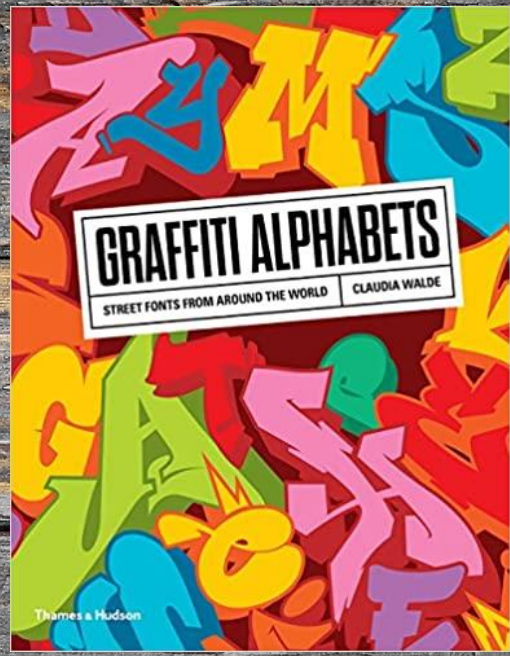
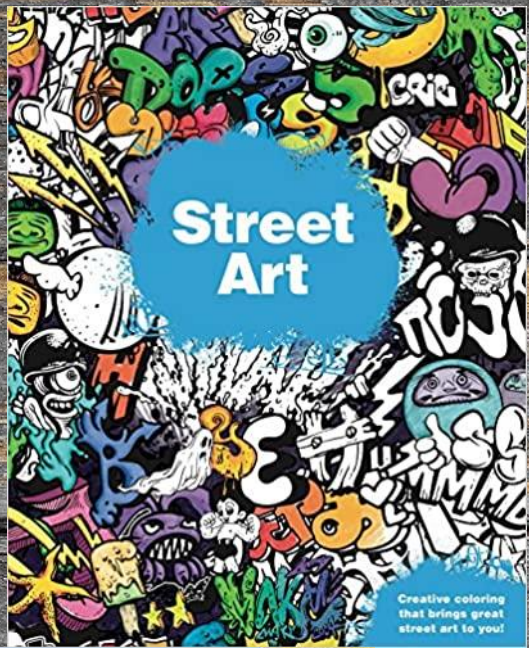
# Year 9 – Project 1 Architecture (mixed media and mono printing part 2)



**What Mrs Waller says...**

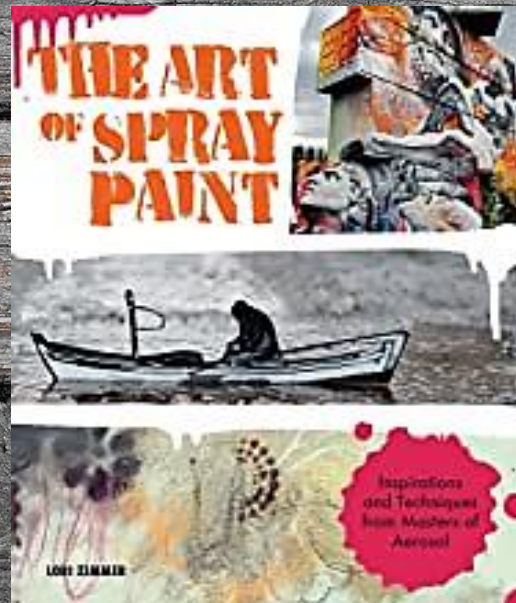
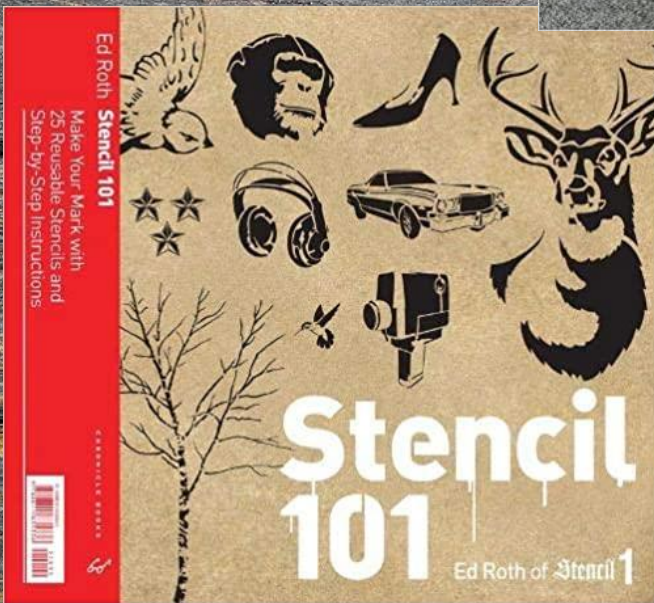
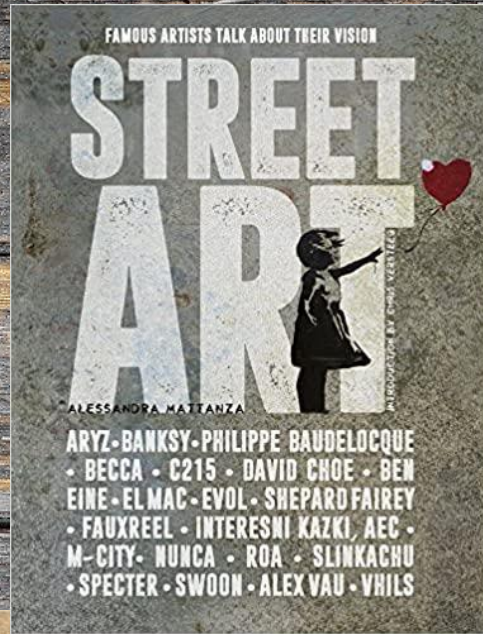
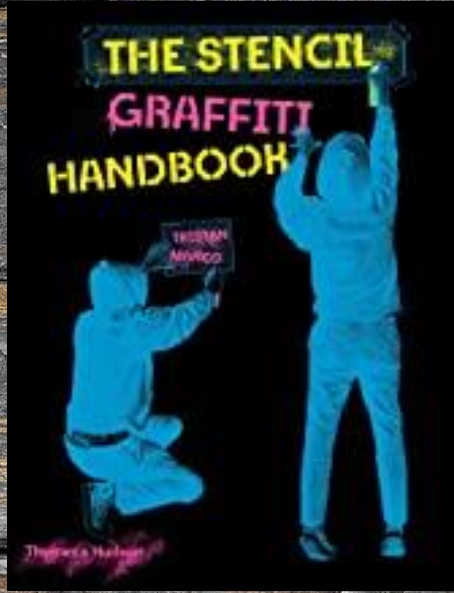

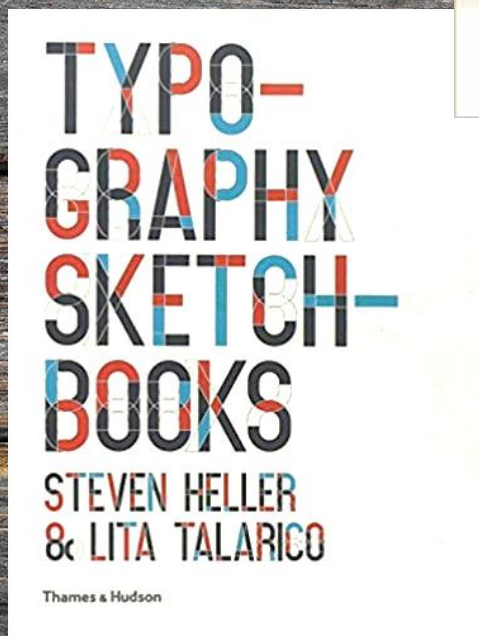
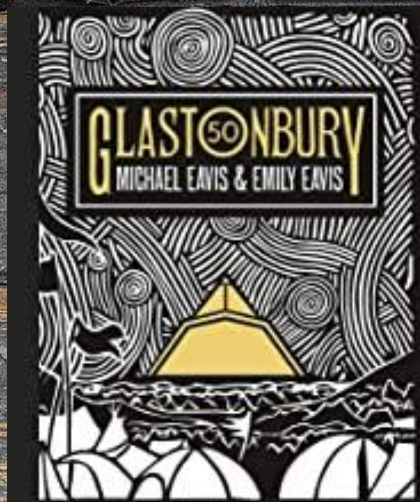
# Year 9 – Project 2 Graffiti (part 2)

## Year 9 – Project 3 Festivals and typography (part 1)

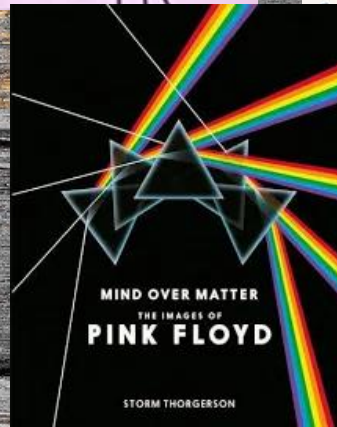
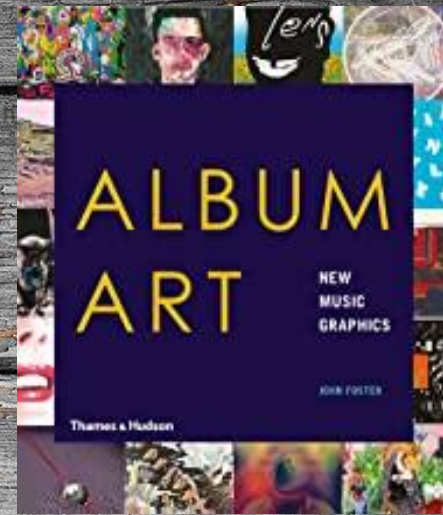


### What Mrs Waller says...
